


The symbols used to tell you what to play are called notes.




The notes on the lines of the stave are: EGBDF

The notes in the spaces of the stave are: F A C E

The Bass Clef




The notes on the lines of the stave are: G B D F A

The notes in the spaces of the stave are: A C E G

The Grand Stave

The grand stave is made from the treble and bass staves.

The two staves are joined by "middle C", the note in the middle of the two staves.
