Music literacy is a language used to share music through reading and writing.

This language is written using special symbols that tell you what to play and how to play it.





Rhythm is made up of beats and the gaps between the beats.

The beats and gaps are put together to form patterns.

When the patterns are repeated, a rhythm is formed





Music is made up of many sounds.

The sounds can be high, medium and low.

Pitch is the level of sound that is made.





A melody is a group of notes played one after the other.

Another name for melody is tune.

Harmony is also a group of notes played one after the other, but supports the melody.





Dynamics describe how loud or soft the music is played.

It also describes how the music is played.

Italian names are usually used to describe dynamics.



f - forte - loud

p - piano - quiet

Crescendo - becoming louder

Decrescendo - becoming softer
