

A scale is a group of musical notes getting higher or lower in a set order. The distance between each successive note is called a scale step.

The main type of scales are chromatic and diatonic scales.




A chromatic scale is a series of twelve notes, each a semitone or half step apart.

- C Tonic the first note of a scale
- D Subtonic
- E Mediant
- F Subdominant
- G Dominant
- A Submediant
- B Leading note



The key refers to the note on which the scale begins.

The key is C.
