



Playing Surface




A note is a raised area on the playing surface.

Grooves



The notes are separated by the grooves.






The rim is the edge around the playing surface

The playing surface and the skirt are joined at the rim.






The edge is end of the pan which is opposite to the rim.

Skirt



Holes



The holes are made at either side of the pan.

They are threaded with string to hold the pans on stands





The belly is the curved area underneath the pan.
