Pan Jam's steelpan workshop is for anyone regardless of age, who would like to get the experience of playing steelpans for the first time, as well as established steelpan players and spectators wanting to take in the atmosphere.

The aims of the workshop are as follows:

- To support the steelpan movement in the east of England.
- To give all participants a chance to work with one of the country's top steelpan arrangers.
- To give the participants an opportunity to perform as part of a steel orchestra.

The day's event will be led by Delphina 'Panness' James, a former UK steelpan soloist champion and member of Ebony steelband, the most successful UK Panorama winning steelband.

Pan Jam is also bringing together several steelbands from the local area to perform on the day.

The finale of the day's events will be a combined performance by the workshop participants and guest steelbands.

This event will take place between 9 am and 5 pm on Saturday, 7 March 2015 at Chesterton Community College, Cambridge. The cost of this event is £8. The concert starts at 4 pm and is free to friends and family of the participants. Some refreshments will be provided throughout the day - please bring a packed lunch if possible.
